The Position:

Animal Shelter Specialist/Animal Control Officer I – Full-time position under general supervision, performing a variety of duties involved in the enforcement of State laws, Town ordinances, and regulations relating to animal control and impounding of animals; performs related work as assigned. The position requires weekend, evenings, holidays and emergency work.

Qualifications:

Knowledge, Skills and Abilities

A working knowledge of the handling and routine care of domestic and wild animals; methods and techniques of animal capture and impoundment; animal types/breeds and behavior patterns; symptoms of animal illness and disease. Ability to communicate clearly and concisely, both orally and in writing; research and prepare reports on animal control related subjects; various office duties including computer skills; establish and maintain effective relationships with the community at large; lure, confine and control animals which may be vicious; administer licensed drugs to animals; use and care for animal snare, capture rope, traps and related equipment; on a regular basis, lift animals weighing up to 100 pounds; perform work that requires moderate physical activity; respond to emergency and problem situations in an effective manner; understand, explain and apply policies and procedures; prepare routine reports and maintain records; deal constructively with conflict and develop effective resolutions; meet the public in situations requiring diplomacy and tact; work outdoors in all types of weather conditions; determine the extent of injuries or illness of animals and refer for appropriate care.

Minimum Qualifications:

High school diploma or equivalent with one year experience in a related field. The position requires ability to pass a pre-employment drug and tuberculosis screen, medical exam and a criminal background check; possess a California driver's license with a satisfactory driving record. Possession of or ability to acquire current certification for first aid, CPR, euthanasia, tranquilizing animals and the PC832 requirement.
