The Town of Yucca Valley is updating its General Plan and needs input from everyone in the community.

### *What is a General Plan?*

A General Plan is a set of long-term goals and policies that decision makers will use to guide growth in the Town of Yucca Valley for the next several decades. General Plans address a variety of issues including land use, housing, economic development, community design, transportation, open space, parks and recreation, infrastructure, natural resources, public safety and noise. State law requires that every City or Town adopt a General Plan.

### *Why update the General Plan?*

The Town's current General Plan was last adopted in 1995. Over time, the needs and values of the community may have changed. Updating the General Plan is an opportunity for the Town to comprehensively evaluate the community's priorities and aspirations. The General Plan will also develop strategies to sustain the quality of life and economic prosperity desired by Town residents and businesses. The General Plan will create a contemporary vision for the future that reflects the local values of residents, businesses, and Town officials.

We are enthusiastic about initiating the General Plan Update and we cannot undertake this significant effort without input from a critical partner - YOU!
