

REGISTRATION

Youth basketball registration is accepted in person at the Yucca Valley Community Center, Mon. - Thurs., 12pm to 5pm, or online at:

ELIGIBILITY

Players must meet grade and age requirements. Advanced players may elect to play up one year. Players born in December of the prior year who meet the grade requirement may register by grade upon department approval.

Pee-Wee Basketball

Pee-Wee Basketball is a six-week program designed to develop basic skills and introduce participants to organized practices and scrimmage games. This coed program includes six (6) one-hour practices and six (6) one-hour games. All practices and games are held during the week on the assigned program days. Program is led by staff instructors and parent coaches.

AGE: 1st-2nd Grade - Birth year 2008-2009

COST: \$40 for 6 week session
(Includes T-shirt, picture package, award.)

DAYS: Choose Mon/Wed or Tue/Th class (no Sat.)

DATES: January 11, 2016 - February 18, 2016

TIME: 6:15-7:15 p.m.

PLACE: Boys & Girls Club Gymnasium

REGISTRATION: Closes November 20 (or when filled).



Youth Basketball Recreation League

This recreational league emphasizes skills development and friendly competition. Boys and girls play separately; standings are recorded with awards presented to 1st and 2nd place teams. Teams are coached by parent volunteers; games are officiated by Town referees.

AGE: 3rd-4th Grade - Birth year 2006-2007
5th-6th Grade - Birth year 2004-2005
7th-8th Grade - Birth year 2001-2003

COST: \$60 (includes jersey & picture package)

DAYS: Practices on two weeknights. Games are held on Saturdays (weeknights as needed).

PROGRAM DATES:

Registration: Closes Nov 20 or when filled.

Draft Day Evals: Nov 21 (see below)

Practices: Begin Dec 7; start times vary from 6:00-8:00 p.m.

HOLIDAY CLOSURE: no activities Dec 24 - Jan 3

Games: Jan 9, 2016 - Mar 5, 2016

LOCATIONS:

Gym locations include the Boys & Girls Club, La Contenta Middle School and Evangelical Free Church.

DRAFT DAY PLAYER CLINIC is a basic skills clinic designed to provide an opportunity for coaches and staff to evaluate players in preparation for team picks. This assists in balancing the teams and promoting greater competition in games. The clinic is a player evaluation only, not try-outs; all players will be placed on a team. Attendance is required for all players and coaches in the competitive divisions.

EQUIPMENT

SPECIAL REQUESTS

Competitive teams are formed based on player skill level and therefore special requests cannot be accommodated. Immediate siblings playing in the same division may be placed together if requested at the time of registration.



Coaching Opportunities

Volunteers are needed to coach in our youth sports programs. Must be 18 years of age or older. No experience is necessary. Training and coaching resources are available to support volunteers. All applicants must be approved by the Community Services Department and complete the Town of Yucca Valley volunteer clearance process, including fingerprinting and background check.
