Subject: Request for Information (RFI) #1

### Question 1:

I did a site visit on 6/22/19, I found:

- 1. There are appx. 2,250' of very large asphalt cracks (4" to 16" wide), this includes all the gaps of separation between concrete and asphalt/walls. (It needs to cut out 18" wide x 3" deep & repave)
- There are many potholes and damaged areas by tree roots that need to be patched or replaced with hot mix asphalt before slurry seal coats.
- 3. There are some slot patches needed at the new PCC curbing.
- 4. There are 8 broken / poor condition 4' concrete wheelstops that need to be removed & replaced
- 5. The 2 existing HC signs/posts need to be replaced.
- 6. The existing concrete end ramp needs 3'x4' truncated dome per ADA standards.
- 7. Can the Gift shop & Visitor Center be closed during construction? or how many Phases are needed for this project?

#### Response:

Items 1-6 will all be completed by Town forces prior to work under this contract beginning.

#### Question 2:

The specs call for GuardTop slurry seal or equivalent. Is Gold Coat HP-310 slurry seal an acceptable alternate?
