If you live in the incorporated limits of the Town of Yucca Valley, you may reach Animal Control Services at:

Hours of operation for the Town's Animal Control are Monday through Friday, excluding holidays and weekends, 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. If you would have a request for services during regular working hours, please call 760-365-2807 and we will assist you.

We also receive requests for animal control service on line. If you wish to submit a Request for Animal Control Services online, please go to\_\_\_\_\_\_\_, follow the directions given and fill out the work order request form. We will respond to your service requests as soon as possible. Please note, we do not respond to emergency service requests through this system. If you have an emergency, please refer to the information provided below.

## Weekends/After hours & Holiday Emergencies

If you have an emergency, please call the Sheriff's Dispatch at 760-365-2364. Sheriff's Dispatch will contact the Animal Control Officer who is on duty for after hours emergency calls. Emergency calls *do not* include loose dogs, confined strays on your property or barking dogs. If you have an animal that you wish to turn in, you may either:

- Take the animal to the Yucca Valley Animal Shelter, 56460 Paseo Los Ninos, Yucca Valley, CA. 760-365-3111. Take Hwy. 247 north to Skyline Ranch Road, turn left and go to the end of the pavement and turn right on Malin Way. From there you will drive straight to the animal shelter. There is a night drop, located outside the office, for animal brought in after hours, or you may;
- Keep the animal till the next working day and call Animal Control Services to come pick up the animal then.
