2018-19 Youth Commission



The Town Council established the Youth Commission to be appointed annually to serve as an advisory group on youth related issues and to serve the community.

The Council has appointed the Parks, Recreation and Cultural Commission to oversee the activities of the Youth Commission. The following report is an overview of our activities for the term.

Youth Commissioners assisted the Recreation staff in the presentation of special events this year. We provided volunteer service at Town events including the Healthy Hearts Run and the Grubstakes Run. We assisted with set up and clean up and also hosted the raffle and awards ceremonies – a great opportunity for public speaking practice!

We also assisted the Recreation staff with the production of special holiday events. This included float construction and participation in the Festival of Lights Parade; hosting of a Cocoa & Cookies station at the Holiday Craft Fair; and presentation of the annual Easter Egg Hunt.

To fulfill our mission of representing the youth of the community and to exchange viewpoints and ideas, we hosted a roundtable event with the Parks, Recreation and Cultural Commission.

We developed a presentation called YV Teens 2025 to share our insights on the future - including topics such as teen specific retail, a Recreation Center with teen activities, and our ideas for future recreation programs.



The Youth Commission continued its service to local teens through the presentation of a Teen Parking Lot Party on May 11th.

This large scale event was part of the Community Health Fair hosted by the Town of Yucca Valley and The Morongo Basin Healthcare District.

215 teens and kids checked in for wristbands at this exciting themed area that featured an 85 foot inflatable obstacle course, jumbo games, a dunk tank, raffle, and airbrush t-shirt artist.





















In addition to the fun activities, we hosted a survey station for the Skate Park Redesign Project, collecting 76 written surveys.

After the event, we were treated to a pizza party and certificates from the Healthcare District for hosting the teen zone.





The Youth Commission also presented its traditional middle school forum at Joshua Springs Christian School and La Contenta Middle School in May. The presentation included information on the Youth Commission as well as providing encouragement and tips on making the transition from middle school to high school. The students enjoy the group games and it gives us an opportunity to practice public speaking!
