Town Launches #YuccaTogether Economic Assistance Program in response to the COVID – 19 Public Health Emergency

The Town of Yucca Valley understands the dire financial impact the current COVID-19 public health emergency is having on our local businesses. At the meeting of March 31st, the Town Council unanimously approved the #YuccaTogether Economic Assistance Package, to help our community's small businesses which are vital to our local economy. "This is a great way for the Town to assist our small businesses that make up the fabric of our community." said Mayor Jeff Drozd.

The #YuccaTogether Economic Assistance Program includes a waiver of fees for the Town's Business Registration Program, the waiver of renewal fees for short-term vacation rentals, and a 90-day filing extension to our local hotelier's transient occupancy taxes (TOT).

Additionally, a Measure Y Loan/Grant Program has been established as part of the #YuccaTogether Economic Assistance Package. This program is intended for small, local businesses with less than \$1.0 million in annual revenue to fill as a bridge for other funding sources. Loans and grants of up to \$5,000 are being funded through Measure Y.

The program will be offered through June 30, 2020.
