El Mirage Dry Lake

Most visitors enter from US Highway 395 near Adelanto by taking Chamberlaine Way west to Koala Road. Turn right on Koala Road and follow the signs toward the town of El Mirage. At El Mirage Road, turn left. Just east of the town of El Mirage, take Mountain View Road north to enter the El Mirage OHV Recreation Area.

Johnson Valley OHV Area


The riding area can be entered from Highway 247 at Old Woman Springs Road or Camp Rock Road, 55 miles southeast of Barstow. Most visitors access the area off Camp Rock Road by driving north off of Highway 247. Staging for many competitive events is at Anderson Dry Lake, 10 miles north of Highway 247 and east of Camp Rock Road.

Stoddard Valley OHV Area

The triangular-shaped riding area is formed by Interstate 15 and California Highway 247 (Barstow Road), immediately south of Barstow. Most visitors access the area to the east, off Interstate 15 at the Outlet Center Drive Exit (Sidewinder Road) or at the Hodge Road Exit, to the south on I-15.

Rasor OHV Area

The riding area is located between Interstate 15 and the Mojave National Preserve, about 25 miles southwest of Baker. Access roads are Basin Road and Rasor Road east of the I-15. Both of these roads are graded dirt roads.

Applicable Laws

Listed below are some of the violations that an Off Highway Vehicle (OHV) rider could be cited for if stopped for operating an OHV. Other violations not listed may apply.

Registration

California Vehicle Code, (CVC) 4000a:

No person shall drive, move, or leave standing upon a highway, any motor vehicle unless it is registered and appropriate fees have been paid. (A green or red sticker is not valid registration for use on the highway.)

License Required

CVC 12500a: No person shall drive a motor vehicle upon a highway unless that person holds a valid license.
