

Town of Yucca Valley Youth Commission

Did you know that the Town of Yucca Valley has a Youth Commission? The Youth Commission was established in 1995 to provide for communication between Yucca Valley's elected officials and the young people of the community.

Students in grades 7 through 12 are eligible to serve on the Yucca Valley Youth Commission. A limited number of Youth Commissioners are appointed each year, with an effort to represent a variety of schools and grades. Previous commissioners may be reappointed to serve additional terms. Appointments are made in the fall with Commission members serving during the school year. The Youth Commission is not active in the summer months.

Students may apply to serve on the Youth Commission by completing an application.

Applications are available online at www.yucca-valley.org. The deadline to return a completed application for the 2023-24 program is November 1, 2023.

Each year, Youth Commissioners serve the community through volunteering for Town programs, hosting youth activities, and discovering creative and effective ways to communicate with the young people of the community. The Youth Commission is meets regularly with Town of Yucca Valley staff members to accomplish their goals. Activity reports are presented to the Parks, Recreation, and Cultural Commission and a final report is given to the Town Council. Meetings are held monthly.

Youth Commission Appointment Guidelines

- 1. The Yucca Valley Youth Commission is comprised of individuals in 7th through 12th grades.
- Applications and supplementary materials must be submitted to the Community Center by November 1, 2023. Recommendations for appointment will be made by the Parks, Recreation and Cultural Commission.
- 3. Returning Youth Commissioners must submit an application to be recommended for reappointment by Community Services Department staff. Additional letters of recommendation and essay are not required applicant recommendation will be based on the candidate's prior service.
- 4. Every effort shall be made to establish a representation of the most schools and grades in recommending Youth Commission appointees.
- 5. Youth Commissioners will be limited to serving no more than three consecutive terms if the number of applicants exceeds the number of authorized seats.
- 6. Commissioners will be required to attend Youth Commission meetings once a month during the school year. Excessive absences during the term will result in dismissal.
