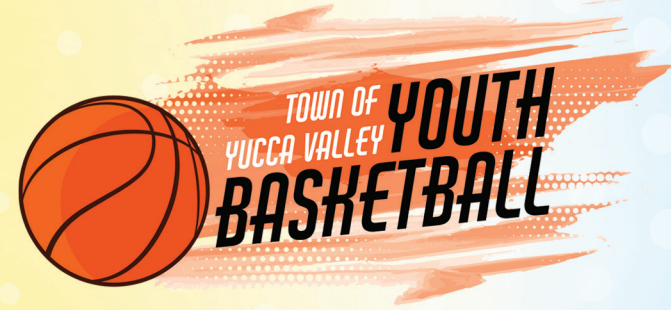
treat other players, coaches, spectators and officials with respect regardless of any differences.

ELIGIBILITY

- Players must meet grade and age requirements.
- Advanced players may elect to play up one year.
- Players born in December of the prior year who meet the grade requirement may register by grade upon department approval.

WEE HOOPS BASKETBALL



Wee Hoops Basketball is a coed youth basketball program designed to introduce participants to the fundamentals of basketball in an organized practice and game setting. Class format includes one lesson per week for six weeks (6 one-hour lessons).

Instruction includes a combination of fun learning and scrimmage style games. All class activities are held during the week on the assigned program days. The program is led by staff instructors.
