Samantha Herrmann:

Thank you for submitting the above referenced application which the Town of Yucca Valley received a deposit payment for on November 8, 2023. The Town received the outstanding Biological Assessment on October 17, 2024. In accordance with Government Code Section 65943, the Town has thirty (30) days within which to notify an applicant, in writing, that an application is complete or that additional materials will be required.

The application is deemed <u>complete</u>. Below are comments on the Biological Assessment that are required prior to initiation of CEQA review for the proposed project.

1. Page 10 of the Biological Assessment states that there is a presence of western Joshua trees onsite and that the Town of Yucca Valley requires a Native Plant Permit Application to be completed to address potential impacts to western Joshua trees. The western Joshua tree is <u>not</u> regulated by the Town of Yucca Valley and is not subject to a Native Plant Permit application. The western Joshua tree is regulated under the California Endangered Species Act (CESA) and the Western Joshua Tree Conservation Act (WJTCA) and subject to regulation by the California Department of Fish and Wildlife (CDFW). Please revise the Biological Assessment to reflect CDFW as the regulatory authority for western Joshua trees and provide a full analysis of the potential impacts to both the western Joshua tree <u>and</u> its habitat.
